

TORBAY HALF MARATHON COURSE

New improved course

ONLY ONE LAP OF PAIGNTON GREEN

The improved course will pass beside historic Torre Abbey Mansions and only have one starting lap of Paignton Green.

Towards Torquay runners turn left under the bridge and head up Seaway Lane to the traffic lights and turn right into Torquay Road.

Runners heading back to Paignton turn left into Orient Road and left again in to Seaway Lane.

Turn point is opposite the Torbay Hotel by Torquay Harbourside



The Torbay Half Marathon race is situated in the heart of glorious South Devon.

The 2 lap traffic free course starts on the Promenade near Paignton Seafront (TQ4 6BN).

Before you complete your Entry Form, please read the following notes carefully:

You must be at least 17 years old on race day to enter. St John Ambulance will provide medical cover.

2-Lap Traffic Free Course. Roads will reopen from approx. 11:45am. After this time, runners must continue on the pavement.

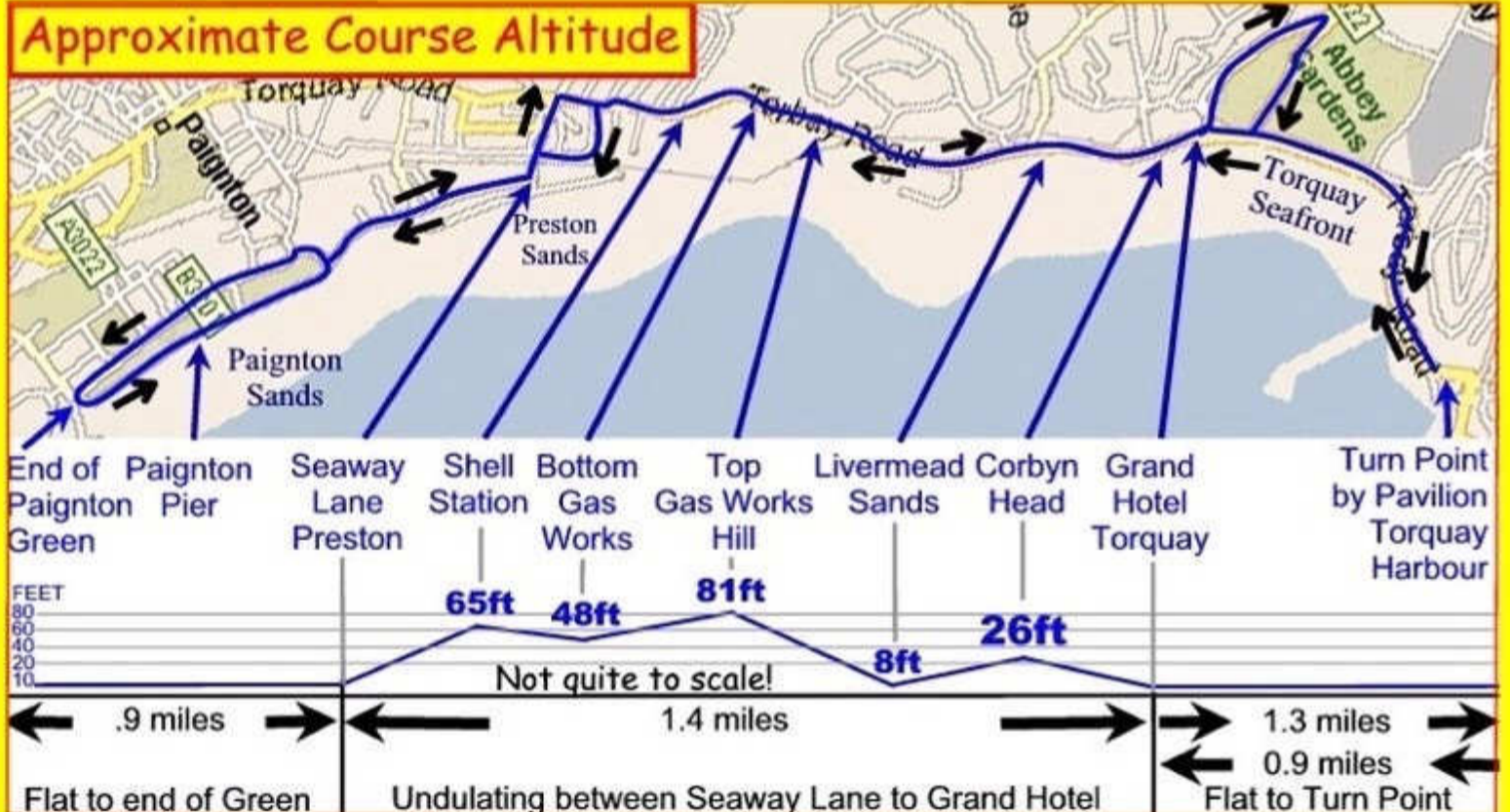
For safety reasons, the use of roller blades or skates, personal stereos and MP3 players etc are prohibited, and their use will lead to disqualification.

You must take part on foot, and must not introduce any animal or wheeled vehicle into the race at any point. If you do so, you will be disqualified. The course is not suitable for wheelchairs.

The entry fee includes return postage, timing chip which must be returned, Quality medal, t-shirt and goody bag for every finisher.

Your acceptance details will be posted on our website after your entry has been processed. Please allow two weeks.
