



Important Road Closure Information

In place from 7:00 hrs until 14:00 hrs

Dear Resident,

The Torbay Half Marathon & 10k will take place on the morning of **Sunday 21 September 2025**.

This is a prestigious event in the athletics calendar. The event raises a large amount of money for many charities and gives a big boost to the local economy.

There is need for a robust highway strategy to be in place, this is fully supported by the Police, Torbay Council and the Public Safety Advisory Group.

The two laps of the Half Marathon will commence at 9:15hrs from Paignton seafront, shortly followed by a 10k run, there will be a full road closure along the course from 7:00hrs with a dynamic re-opening of closures from 12:00hrs.

A diversion route will be in place between Paignton and Torquay.

As well as a total seafront road closure between **Sands Road, Paignton** and **Cary Parade** Torquay, there will be closures at **Orient Road, Morin Road, Manor Road** below the **Morin Road Junction** and **Rathmore Road** to the **Falkland Road Junction** and also **Kings Drive**. With these road closures and diversions in place, vehicular movement will be prohibited or restricted; also on many of these roads parking restrictions will also be in place during the event. Please refer to signage that will be erected seven days prior to the event.

You may be unable to use a vehicle to or from your property during the closure period. If you have to use your vehicle during the event you will need to ensure that it is already outside the closure area. Suitable parking could be some distance from your property.

Please check with public transport providers for changes to timetables.

Please turn over for further information.

The closure will affect residents; hotels and businesses during the event and there will inevitably be some inconvenience for which we apologise in advance. 1. A parking suspension on all parking bays between **Kings Drive** and the **Torbay Hotel** on both carriageways. From 6:00 until 14:00 Sunday 21 September 2025.

2. Morin Road, Paignton – North-west side between junctions with Manor Road and Seaway Road From 8:00 on Saturday 20 September until 14:00 on the Sunday 21 September.

3. Headland Park Road, Paignton – Both sides for its entire length. From 6:00 until 16:00 Sunday 21 September.
